She graduated in 2020, summa cum laude. During her time at Montclair, she received a full-ride scholarship to study operatic voice performance for a year at the Kunstuniversität Graz in Austria. Ms. Meier has performed with professional ensembles such as The Princeton Singers, and as a soloist, has performed with The Princeton Symphony Orchestra. She recently performed as a singer in residence at Lehigh University's Choral Composers Forum, with renowned composer in residence, Ēriks Ešvalds. Ms. Meier has also sung with The Philadelphia Symphonic Chorus, under the conducting of Yannick Nézet-Séguin. Ms. Meier has conducted choirs internationally and has been accepted as a Conducting Fellow at various institutes across the United States. Choirs under Ms. Meier's direction have performed at state-wide festivals and have won regional choral competitions. She is a Choral Director at Grover Middle School of the West Windsor-Plainsboro School District in New Jersey. Ms. Meier is the Associate Director and Conductor of the Eighth Notes Choir and a Co-Director of the Grace Notes Choir with the Princeton Girlchoirs. She also managed the 2023 Princeton Boychoir tour to Carnegie Hall and the 2023 Princeton Girlchoir tour to Spain and Portugal. She currently resides in Princeton, New Jersey. In her spare time, Maddie is a voracious reader, who loves to hike, cook and garden.
